



### Flight Compartment Panels

The main instrument panel has three panels. These are the panels:

- P1
- P2
- P3.

The main instrument panels of the flight compartment include five 8"x8" flat panel liquid crystal display (LCD) units. A sixth LCD is on the P9. All the display units have the same part number. The display units supply a larger display area than conventional cathode-ray tube (CRT) display units. The LCDs have better visibility for the primary navigation and engine information.

The mode control panel (MCP) is on the P7 panel.

These are the aisle stand panels:

- P8 aft electronic panel
- P9 forward electronic panel

- Control stand.

These are the two overhead panels:

- P5 forward overhead panel
- P5 aft overhead panel.
